Subject:- Request for empanelment of Aster Adhar Hospital, Kolhapur & KIMS Kingsway Hospital Nagpur
and request to Expanding PME Facilities Across ONGC Empanelled Hospitals in Maharashtra

Respected Sir,

We have received request from several employees & retired employees for the empanelment of Aster Adhar Hospital, Kolhapur. Many employees & their dependents from West-Maharashtra will be benefited from this empanelment. As Aster Aadhar Hospital, Kolhapur and Kims Kingsway Hospital, Nagpur have submitted the documents to the medical section, Mumbai. Empanelment of these hospitals will largely benefits our employees.

Periodic health checkups ensure the early detection of diseases and disorders. Early detection leads to faster recovery at a lower treatment cost, which, in turn, saves a significant amount of money that might otherwise be spent on prolonged treatments.

The PME for employees and the Jivan Sathi PME scheme of ONGC are excellent initiatives providing the benefit of regular health checkups. Over the last 15 years, employees have been recruited from various parts of Maharashtra, such as Nagpur, Sambhaji Nagar, Pune, Kolhapur, Nashik, etc. Many of these employees perform on-off duty from their respective cities.

The Medical Section in Mumbai is doing commendable work by empanelling hospitals from different cities in Maharashtra, such as Nagpur, Nashik, Pune, Sambhaji Nagar, and others.

Currently, PME and Jivan Sathi PME can only be performed at a few hospitals in Mumbai, Navi Mumbai, and Apollo Hospital in Nashik. Employees on on-off duty are required to stay an extra day in hotels for mandatory PME, which results in employees losing a day from their off period. Additionally, ONGC incurs hotel costs in Mumbai. For such employees, Jivan Sathi PME is also not feasible due to the lack of residential facilities.

Considering these factors, we kindly request you to make the necessary arrangements so that PME can be conducted at all ONGC-empanelled hospitals across Maharashtra. Furthermore, we request that PME be included as part of the contract while empanelling new hospitals in Maharashtra in the future.

We request kindly give the direction to the I/c Medical Section, Mumbai to give us time for meeting for the discussion related to idea of empanelling various hospitals from various regions of Maharashtra, so that employee & spouse will get treatment in nearby cities instead of rushing to the Mumbai.

We appreciate your attention to this matter and look forward to your prompt action.
